Dear Mr. Ian Anderson,

On behalf of Icelandair Special Children Travel Fund, I thank you for your generous donation. Your donation will make it possible for the Fund to fulfill a dream come true for the children and their families to travel together.

Icelandair Special Children Travel Fund supports children with long-term illnesses and children who live with difficult circumstances, as well as their families.

A trip like that is often very much needed, because the illness of a child can have a tremendous effect on the entire family and it is common for siblings and other family members to feel neglected during difficult periods.

The Special Children Travel Fund allows families to take a holiday of their choice to one of Icelandair's destinations abroad. All expenses are paid: flights, accommodation, a rental car, daily allowance, and entrance fees to special events chosen by the child. A total of 270 children and their families have received allocations from the fund since it was established in 2003, and the total number of passengers travelling under its auspices exceeds 1350.

The most popular trip so far has been a week's holiday to Disney World in Florida, but the children have also chosen to travel to other destinations.

The fund was established by Icelandair on the First Day of Summer 2003. Allocations from the fund are made twice a year, on the First Day of Summer and the First Day of Winter in Iceland.

The official foundation of The Special Children Travel Fund builds on the vision and continuous work of Mrs. Peggy Helgason during the past twenty years, making it possible for children in Iceland and nearby countries, suffering from long-term illnesses or other special conditions, and their families and opportunity to live and adventure abroad. Guardian of the fund is Mrs. Vigdís Finnbogadóttir, former President of Iceland.

The Special Children Travel Fund is financed in few ways. First, passengers onboard Icelandair aircraft are invited to donate their change to the fund, and this effort has proven highly successful. Second, members of the Icelandair Frequent Flyer Club are given the opportunity to donate their Award Points. Third, Icelandair makes a substantial contribution to the fund. Fourth, charity contribution boxes in Keflavik airport and at Icelandair Head Office. And fifth, the sale of our Special Angel a teddy bear from Bukowski, all profit will go to Icelandair's Special Children Travel Fund.
